IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL VIKING FESTIVAL, MUSEUM EVENTS.

- All children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Entry to the Museum is through the front entrance doors only. (On the seafront)
- When you book any of our paid events, you qualify to buy a special Viking Pass, giving you museum entry for the whole of the Viking Festival, just £12 for a family of two adults and up to three children. Other Festival Passes, for singles and couples, are also available. Enquire on arrival. That's an incredible five days of entry for the usual one day entry price.
